Learning objectives:</p> <p>I can identify basic factual information in short, simple dialogs or stories on familiar everyday topics, if spoken slowly and clearly.</p> <p>I can talk about familiar topics using a few basic words and phrases.</p> <p>I can write correctly structured questions with question marks.</p> <p>Vocabulary: add, subtract, sum, plus, minus, equals, measure, problem, hide, lost, solve, clue, treasure hunt, maze, entrance, exit.</p> <p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use all object pronouns as compliments with the Present Simple. I can use "can" to refer to ability in the present and near future. <p>Unit 12: Why is it good to be outdoors? Learning objectives:</p> <p>I can identify activities occurring in the past in short, simple dialogs.</p> <p>I can understand short paragraphs on subjects of personal interest, if written using simple language and supported by pictures.</p> <p>I can talk about an event in the past using fixed expressions, given a model.</p> <p>Vocabulary: grass, lake, hills, pond, wildlife, meadow, rocks, sand, fins, snorkel, water wings, air mattress, hotel, shell, seaweed, sandcastle.</p> <p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use "I" with common verbs in regular Past Simple forms, with simple phrasal complements. I can use "Yes, I did. /No, I didn't." to answer questions beginning with "Did you?" 	<p>Science Unit 9: What is movement? Learning objectives:</p> <p>I can identify that objects move fast or slow.</p> <p>I can explain that objects can move in a straight line or a curved line.</p> <p>I can explain that objects move back and forth and in zigzag patterns.</p> <p>I can explain the forces of push and pull.</p> <div data-bbox="824 743 1490 1150" data-label="Diagram"> </div> <p>Vocabulary: straight, curved, back and forth, zigzag, swing, carousel, roll, speed, ramp, slide, push, pull direction, surfaces, friction, smooth.</p> <p>Social Studies: Make memories with your family.</p>
