<p>Unit 11: How are we similar but different?</p> <p>Learning objectives:</p> <p>I can identify clearly stated opinions in extended informal conversations on matters of personal interest, if the speakers use clear standard speech.</p> <p>I can identify supporting details in simple structured paragraphs on familiar topics, if guided by questions.</p> <p>I can talk about basic personal experiences, using simple linking words.</p> <p>I can describe similarities between two people in simple connected text, given a model.</p> <p>GRAMMAR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can use singular verb forms with impersonal pronouns “every/any/no/some+body/where/one/thing.” • I can form questions with prepositional verbs and final prepositions. <p>VOCABULARY: arrogant, feeling, funny, have something in common, honest, imaginative, mean, open, rude, stubborn, talkative, think, thoughtful, vow, care for, collect, constant, frequently, generous, helpful, improve, jerry can, organization, well.</p>	<p>Unit 8 & 9: What are forces and motion?
