ENGLISH

Unit 12: Where do we live?

Learning objectives:

I can understand simple conversations about everyday activities.

I can understand the order of events in a text.

I will ask simple questions about homes.

I can write about my home.

Vocabulary: bathtub, refrigerator, stove, lamp, couch, bookcase, closet, sink, house, townhouse, apartment, cottage, palace, trailer, barge, tree house.

Grammar:

- I can use "Yes, I am. / No, I'm not." to answer questions in the present progressive.
- Using a few simple prepositions of place with common nouns.

Phonics: Vowel-consonant-e (VCe) is a spelling pattern in which a silent e at the end signals a change from the short vowel sound to a long vowel sound (e.g., kit → kite). The lessons in this unit are designed to develop students' skills for reading with words that contain the VCe pattern.
